Feral pigs multiply rapidly, causing serious damage to your crops, livestock, and the environment. But you don't have to face them alone.

Join a baiting or trapping program that uses proven methods — including weeks of free feeding to attract as many pigs as possible before control measures begin.

What you get:

- subsidised grain supply for free feeding, poisoning, and trapping
- access to Vertebrate Pesticide Induction Training - register now: nsw.gov.au/vpit

Are you eligible?

To participate:

- baiting programs must comply with the Pesticide Control Order
- you must hold valid chemical user accreditation or complete Vertebrate Pesticide Induction Training before baiting
- you must undertake a site inspection by a Biosecurity Officer.



Incentives are available until 30 June 2026 and are available to private holdings within the Riverina Local Land Services region.
